



PUBLIC NOTICE: Opportunity for third party comments

Notre Dame College Division of Nursing is preparing to host an accreditation site visit from the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) for the Master of Science in Nursing degree program. The visit is scheduled for October 18-20, 2017.

CCNE is an autonomous accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of the Education as a national accreditation agency, contributing to the improvement of the public's health. CCNE ensures the quality and integrity of baccalaureate, graduate, and residency programs in nursing. CCNE serves the public interest by assessing and identifying programs that engage in effective educational practices. As a voluntary, self-regulatory process, CCNE accreditation supports and encourages continuing self-assessment by nursing programs and supports continuing growth and improvement of collegiate professional education and nurse residency programs.

As part of this process, written and signed third party comments are sought from interested individuals (students, alumni, faculty and community stakeholders) and will be accepted by CCNE until 21 days before the scheduled on-site evaluation; a deadline of September 27, 2017. All third-party comments submitted to CCNE must be written in English, consistent with CCNE's policy on Conduct of Business in English. Any and all comments submitted to CCNE in a language other than English will not be processed.
