

Applying for Summer Financial Aid

Summer Sessions 2012

If you are planning to attend summer session at Notre Dame College, and want to apply for financial aid, you will need to do and know the following:

Things You Need To Do:

1. Complete the 2012—2013 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and have the results submitted to us. (NDC School code 003085.)
2. All new borrowers must complete a [Direct Stafford Loan Master Prom note \(MPN\)](#) and [Entrance Counseling](#) at www.studentloans.gov. No loan funds will be disbursed to the college unless these two steps have been completed.
3. If selected by the federal government, complete the federal verification process. Please check your information at [My NDC](#) for missing documents needed to complete your financial aid award.
4. Complete the [2012—2013 Financial Aid Enrollment Plan Form](#) and return it to the financial aid office once you have filed and received the results of your 2012—2013 FAFSA application. (This form will be returned to you if we do not have the results of your FAFSA on file.)

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW:

1. Summer term at Notre Dame College includes Summer Session One and Summer Session Two.
2. Use of financial aid in the summer will reduce the amount of loans and Pell Grant available to you during the regular 2012—2013 school year.
3. To be eligible for federal financial aid, you must be enrolled at least 6 credit hours between Summer Session One and Summer Session Two or Summer Online for 2012. Remember, you earn your federal funds by maintaining attendance across the entire semester. If you cease to attend or earn all F's, W's, I's, you may lose all or part of these funds based on federal regulations. You must be in compliance with the Standards of Academic Progress. Returning students will be measured against this policy at the end of each semester.
4. Refunds will be issued two weeks after all aid is posted. There are no exceptions.
5. If you are receiving Pell Grant for summer, funds will not be posted to your account until after July 1st.
6. When you register for classes, you must enroll for all sessions at the same time. No funds will apply to your account unless you are in attendance for at least 6 credit hours.
7. If you change your registration, your eligibility for financial aid will be recalculated; this could cause you to owe funds to the college. Please be sure of your plans before submitting this form.
