Greetings from the Career Corner in the Academic Support Center! I would like to discuss the internship/cooperative education (co-op) component that is required for graduation by Notre Dame College. At Notre Dame College, students can complete an internship or co-op that can give them real life experience in the field that they are interested in. This opportunity also allows students at NDC to gain the networking, interviewing, and resume writing skills needed to be successful upon graduation.

Here are some basic things you need to know about this exciting opportunity!

- To be considered, students must have completed 28 hours of credit, be in good academic standing, and have a cumulative GPA of at least a 2.0
- For each credit hour you would like to receive for the co-op or internship, you must work 45 hours at the internship site (up to a maximum of 6 credit hours)
- The internship is a requirement for all Bachelor of Arts students at NDC with the exception of Nursing, Psychology, and Education majors
- The internship/co-op must relate to the students field of study
