

Important Information for Student Loan Borrowers

If you are accepting your federal Direct loan(s), there are two steps you are required by the federal government to complete before your loan(s) can post to your student account:

1. Complete a Master Promissory Note (MPN). The MPN is your legal agreement to repay your loan(s) and any accrued interest and fees.
2. Complete Student Loan Entrance Counseling. Entrance counseling explains your rights and responsibilities as a federal loan borrower.

To complete your MPN and Entrance Counseling, go to www.studentloans.gov. Sign in, using your FSA ID and password. To complete your MPN, select “Complete Master Promissory Note” from the menu options. To complete entrance counseling, select “Complete Entrance Counseling” from the menu options.
