The Federal TEACH Grant Program provides grant assistance to students admitted to the college in either an undergraduate or graduate degree seeking program, who agree to serve for at least four years as full-time “highly qualified” teachers in high-need fields in public or not-for-profit private elementary or secondary schools that serve students from low-income families. A TEACH Grant recipient who does not complete the required teaching service within eight years of completing his or her academic program, subject to certain exceptions, or fails to meet certain other requirements of the TEACH Grant Program, must repay the TEACH Grant as a Direct Unsubsidized Loan under the William D. Ford Federal Direct Loan Program with interest, accrued from the date the TEACH Grant was disbursed.

All TEACH grant recipients must submit a FAFSA each year. For first-time application, please complete and submit this form to the NDC Office of Financial Aid. For renewal of a TEACH grant, recipients must maintain the 3.25 GPA requirement and remain in a qualifying program (as indicated below). The TEACH Grant Agreement to Serve (ATS) and TEACH Grant counseling must be completed each year.
