



# READING ENDORSEMENT PROGRAM

## FULLY ONLINE!



The Notre Dame College Reading Endorsement prepares teachers who serve grades PreK-12 to meet the needs of a range of readers using evidence-based literacy methodology.

The program consists of the five three-credit courses (listed to the left). One literacy course completed at the grad/undergrad level can be transferred in if the course content matches a NDC course.

Courses may be completed in any order, with the exception of EDD 655. The Reading Practicum must be the final course completed in the sequence.

Each course is 8 weeks in length, except EDD655 which is 16 weeks in length.

**Pre-requisites include a current teaching license and evidence of 12 hours of literacy coursework that meet Ohio's initial licensure Reading Core. This must include a phonics course. AYA license holders only need 9 hours of literacy coursework, and do not need a phonics course.**
