Transfer Guide for Cuyahoga Community College

Notre Dame welcomes Tri-C transfer students! This guide provides information to assist Cuyahoga Community College students in selecting courses for meeting applicable Core and Major requirements at Notre Dame College under NDC's 2017-2018 Catalog. Transfer credit is awarded for all college-level coursework (numbered 1000 and above) in which a grade of "C-" or higher is earned. Bachelor's degree requirements include earning a minimum of 36 semester credits of upper level (300 and 400) coursework. Sometimes a community college course is counted as fulfilling a content requirement of Notre Dame course even though the Notre Dame course is a higher-level course. Please note, however, that no upper level credit is granted for the transferred course. No course can count toward two core requirements. A major cannot be earned at NDC without some courses from the major taken at NDC. For clarification of NDC's requirements, call the Advising Center at 216-373-5383.
