The Department of Biology at Notre Dame College is seeking applicants for a full-time (9 month) Assistant Professor faculty position with expertise in human anatomy and physiology and/or exercise science.

Job Summary

- Teaching a minimum of 24 credit hours per year within Biology, including but not limited to courses in Human Anatomy and Physiology, Nutrition, and Exercise Physiology
- Advising students and assisting students within the exercise science concentration in finding internship or practicum opportunities within physical therapy, exercise science, or related fields
- Helping to develop new curriculum as required within the applicant's area of expertise
- Participating in service to the college, professional development, and other scholarly activities

While Notre Dame College is primarily a teaching institution, faculty are also encouraged to participate in research and other scholarly activities, with a goal of providing mentoring to undergraduate students through these activities.

Qualifications

Candidates should have a Ph.D. in exercise science, physiology, or a related field. Candidates with an M.S. may be considered only if they have significant teaching experience as well as at least 18 credit hours of graduate coursework involving anatomy, physiology, and/or exercise science.
