Notre Dame College invites applications for a **part-time instructor in philosophy** for the 2022-23 academic year. The college seeks a candidate with a master's degree or higher in the discipline of philosophy who has a demonstrable record of teaching excellence. The successful candidate will teach general education philosophy requirements which include courses in Ethics, Critical Thinking, and History of Philosophy. The part-time instructor position has a 3-course fall/3-course spring teaching load with no expectation of committee service or student advising duties. In support of the college's mission of educating a diverse population, women and minorities are strongly encouraged to apply.
